We practice trust-based philanthropy and participatory grantmaking processes as we work to shift philanthropy to community-led solutions. You become part of a community of donors committed to building a future that expands opportunity and equality for all.

What is a DAF?

A donor advised fund at Liberty Hill is the philanthropic vehicle of choice for the progressive donors of Los Angeles. Upon opening a donor advised fund, you will focus on recommending your grants for impact, while we handle the grantmaking process, due diligence, accounting, and if desired, the investment of the fund balance in ESG companies. You avert the red tape, expense, and siloed funding of a private foundation, joining instead a vibrant community for progressive philanthropy. The DAF's low administrative fees are reinvested into the campaigns and operations of Liberty Hill, fueling more power-building and social change.

Our Philanthropic Advisory Services

We approach philanthropy with an equity and justice lens. Through philanthropic advising, we support DAF clients in developing a values-driven giving plan and identifying organizations at the local or national level that are leading or emerging on key issues. Applying an equity lens, we research and recommend organizations rooted in communities that have been historically overlooked by traditional philanthropy and are generating new solutions to confront long-term racial and social inequities. With more than 40 years of history as Los Angeles' leading social justice grantmaker, Liberty Hill's experience can help you have the most impact.

In addition to docket research, your DAF team will provide tools and opportunities to learn with peers through online DAF discussions, strategic philanthropy workshops, and giving circles such as the XX Fund for gender justice and equality or the BLACC Fund for supporting emerging organizations in Black communities.
